We will be fundraising for Red Nose Day 13th March, Wear something red (or your own clothes) and donate £1 to Comic Relief.


Parents Coffee Morning

The Nursery will take part in 'World Book Day' on 5th March. Children will be asked to dress up as there favorite book character.




